
Dear Acting Director McGettigan,

These services include those administered by the Social Security Administration, passport offices, the Internal Revenue Service, Veterans Affairs, and other government agencies. In fact, the current operating status of the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) is “Open with maximum telework.”¹
