- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Life on Col-

1	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON AWARD OF FUNDS TO CERTAIN
2	INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.
3	(a) Prohibition.—No Federal funds may be award-
4	ed (directly or indirectly, including through a contract or
5	subcontract) to any institution of higher education that
6	hosts or is affiliated with any school-based service site that
7	provides abortion drugs or abortions to students of the
8	institution or to employees of the institution or site.
9	(b) Annual Reporting.—To remain eligible for
10	awards of Federal funds, an institution of higher edu-
11	cation that hosts or is affiliated with one or more school-
12	based service sites shall submit an annual report to the
13	Secretary of Education and the Secretary of Health and
14	Human Services certifying that no such site provides abor-
15	tion drugs or abortions to students of the institution or
16	to employees of the institution or site.
17	(c) Definitions.—In this section:
18	(1) The term "abortion drug" means any drug,
19	substance, or combination of drugs or substances
20	that is intended for use or that is in fact used (irre-
21	spective of how the product is labeled)—
22	(A) to intentionally kill the unborn child of
23	a woman known to be pregnant; or
24	(B) to intentionally terminate the preg-
25	nancy of a woman known to be pregnant, with
26	an intention other than—

1	(i) to produce a live birth; or
2	(ii) to remove a dead unborn child.
3	(2) The term "institution of higher education"
4	has the meaning given to such term in section 101
5	of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
6	1001).
7	(3) The term "school-based service site"
8	means—
9	(A) a health clinic that—
10	(i) meets the definition of a school-
11	based health center under section
12	2110(c)(9)(A) of the Social Security Act
13	(42 U.S.C. 1397jj(c)(9)(A)) and is admin-
14	istered by a sponsoring facility (as defined
15	in section $2110(c)(9)(B)$ of the Social Se-
16	curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1397jj(c)(9)(B)));

18	(ii) provides, at a minimum, com-
19	prehensive primary health services during
20	school hours by health professionals in ac-
